# Villager Magazine

The Villager is a monthly magazine, distributed free to all households. It gives details of most activities in the village.

#### **Memorial Hall**

The Hall is situated in the village, and is available for all occasions, parties, receptions etc. It has the capacity for 250 with a modern kitchen and a car park.

#### The Parish Church of St. Peter

The church is 12<sup>th</sup> century and they hold regular services with a vibrant outreach programme.

The incumbent is the local Rural Dean, the Rev. Canon David Sherwin.

#### Schools

The majority of children in the Parish attend either Martley C. of E. Primary school (which also runs a pre-school / nursery) or The Chantry Academy. More information can be found on their individual websites.

## **Doctors**

The parish is served by two doctors' surgeries, one at Great Witley (which also holds limited surgeries in St. Peters Drive, Martley), the other at Knightwick.

Malvern and Tenbury hospitals operate a weekday minor injuries unit and full accident and emergency facilities are available at Worcester Royal Hospital.

#### **Defibrillators**

There are 2 public defibrillators in the village: in the telephone box on the weighbridge and in the box outside The Admiral Rodney.

# Shopping

Central Stores, in the middle of Martley, offers a wide range of products and there is a Post Office within the store.

Central garage services and MOTs cars and motorcycles.

There is an independent butcher in nearby Knightwick.

There is an alternate weekly collection every Monday (Tuesday for some areas outside the village) with recycling collected one week and household waste the next.

The nearest Household recycling centre is at hallow road, off Horsford Road, Worcester WR2 6BZ. A garden waste service is also available.
